

Furthermore, he is President of the Latin American Parties Union (UPLA) 2021/2023 and delegate to the International Democrat Union (IDU).

The Department of Economy and Trade works with a **comprehensive view of reality**, combining technical and academic knowledge with the experience of productive actors, workers and employers.



SINO-ARGENTINE OBSERVATOR

The Observatory of the strategic relationship between Argentina and China is an organization of professionals that operates under the auspices of the New Generations Foundation and is made up of young Argentine researchers, academics and politicians who are dedicated to studying the link between those two countries.

The Observatory is directed by **Patricio Giusto** and **Vicente Teruggi** is its Programme Director. Both are accompanied by a large team of young professionals with experience, training and concerns regarding the bilateral relationship. The Observatory also has an Advisory Council composed of prominent analysts, diplomats, academics and politicians with extensive experience and recognised expertise in the relationship between Argentina and China. This Council is chaired by the former Ambassador of Argentina to China, Dr. Diego Guelar.

The main objective of the Observatory is to **promote the comprehensive study of the political, economic and social reality of the People's Republic of China, from an Argentine perspective**, in order to encourage the mutual understanding and bilateral relations, providing a strategic vision of the relationship.



INSTITUTE OF BI-REGIONAL STUDIES (MERCOSUR-EU)

The Institute for Bi-regional Studies has among its main objectives the **monitoring of the main economic and commercial aspects derived from the trade agreement between Mercosur and the European Union**, the political and commercial development of the member countries of both blocs and the new challenges ahead for Mercosur and the EU.

The Institute seeks, through its studies and actions, to **disseminate the advantages of the bi-regional integration process** and to raise awareness of the impact that the bi-regional agreement will bring to each region, from a commercial, cultural, economic and social point of view. This Institute is an instrument that aims to improve the quality of life of the citizens of both blocs, with a special focus on technological, educational and cultural progress, as well as topics related to work and trade.

The Institute is composed of outstanding professionals with extensive experience in the **development of public policies and trade negotiations**, from both the American and European continent, and has two main operational headquarters: Buenos Aires (Argentina) and Madrid (Spain).

PUBLICATIONS AND ACTIVITIES

Training:

Workshops and seminars: Throughout the year, the New Generations Foundation holds workshops and seminars on topics related to its speciality. These are aimed at policy and decision makers at the three levels of government (municipal, provincial and national).

Eurmodelo Joven: The Fundación Nuevas Generaciones, together with the Delegation of the European Union in Argentina, the Centro de Estudio y Desarrollo of Uruguay, the Fundación Revel of Colombia and the Fundación Idea País of Chile, has been running the Euromodelo Joven for two years in Argentina, Uruguay and Chile. This programme is aimed at university students and, in addition to promoting democratic values, provides an opportunity to get closer to the institutions of the European Union.

Monthly, half-yearly and annual publications:

Public Policies: Throughout the year, public policy proposals are presented to national, provincial and local legislators and, at the end of each semester, the set of public policies prepared by the Public Policies team of Nuevas Generaciones is compiled in a book called "Public Policies", which is published on a biannual basis.


Reports on government measures: This is a compilation of the main measures and public policies implemented or announced by the Government of the Argentine Republic during each year. This monitoring is carried out by our Public Policy and Parliamentary Advisory team in coordination with the Foundation's Press and Communication team.

Monitoring report on the political landscape of Argentine provinces: This report sets out the date of the upcoming elections, the current legislators and governors, the main political figures at national and provincial level, and the electoral weight of each Argentine province.

Realidad Magazine: A weekly digital magazine published by Nuevas Generaciones, in international cooperation with the leading German Hanns Seidel Foundation, which disseminates brief thoughts and opinions that help to encourage further debate on the values and political ideas that should guide the actions of those who have responsibilities in the public and partisan spheres. In this magazine, responding to the spirit and the federal composition that guide our organization, a privileged space for debate is provided to politicians and opinion makers from all the provinces and municipalities of Argentina.

Monthly Report on the Relationship between Argentina and China (Sino-Argentine Observatory): In accordance with the objective of the Sino-Argentine Observatory, which is to promote the comprehensive study of the political, economic and social reality of the People's Republic of China from an Argentine perspective, in order to contribute to the deepening of mutual understanding and bilateral relations, providing a strategic vision of the relationship, a monthly report is published to analyse commercial, cultural and political aspects of the relationship between the two countries.

Fact sheet on the Mercosur-European Union Strategic Partnership Agreement: Published monthly by the Institute for Bi-regional Studies of Nuevas Generaciones, the aim of this report is to provide a detailed analysis of relevant and current aspects of the discussions around the ratification of the Mercosur-European Union partnership agreement.



Economic Resources Transparency



The Foundation receives funds from the private sector (donations or service contracts), from the public sector (through service contracts) and from the third sector (cooperation). It also receives international cooperation from different countries and international organizations, which is why all its programmes are executed under strict standards of transparency and its accounts are audited by the international agents that provide it with cooperation funds.


Active role in media
